IT Services in College

About I.T. Services

I.T. throughout your time at Cambridge will be a mixture of University-wide services run by the University Information Service (UIS), and services provided by your institutions (College and department). Each institution runs slightly differently, but will generally have a first-line support system such as a support email or Service Desk.

The Murray Edwards I.T. Service Desk runs 9am-5pm Monday-Friday, and there's usually at least one person from the I.T. team working in the office during these hours.


How to get in touch:

We only ask that you select the closest description of your issue as a **Help Topic** and fill in the requested details. Being given these details in your original request helps us see things from your perspective straight away and cuts straight to the problem.

We will get back to you as soon as we can, we often have user support duties outside the I.T. office, so there might not always be someone there.

Get Connected to Wi-Fi

You can use UniOfCam with your Raven login, but you'll have to sign in every time you connect. We recommend eduroam which can be set up from any network, i.e. your home Wi-Fi or on UniOfCam if you're in College.

Printing

The main printer for students is called Mur_FindMe and can be accessed once a small configuration app is installed. Access setup instructions using this link.



Printing and copying is charged at 5p per sheet for A4 monochrome, 25p per sheet for A4 colour, 10p per sheet for A3 monochrome and 50p per sheet for A3 colour. Charges are added to your College bill at the end of each term.

Rules

Do not use the network for illegal activities, which includes the unauthorised downloading of copyrighted material, such as films, TV programmes and music. In addition the network must not be used in a way that causes interference, distress or disruption to other users.

You must keep your devices protected against viruses and malware; the University provides <u>free antivirus software</u>⁴. Failure to do so can result in withdrawal of access to IT resources, including the network, and possible disciplinary action. Additionally, you should <u>keep your operating system up-to-date</u>⁵.
